The New Hill Community Association has recently received some of the email correspondence we requested from the Towns of Apex and Cary.

We understand from reading this information that Mayor Weatherly of Apex sent a letter to Mayor McAlister of Cary stating that the Town of Apex agreed with the decision to put the Wastewater Treatment Facility on the site in the center of New Hill.

Apparently, due to a clerical error, this letter was sent without the Apex Board voting on the site selection. In fact, the matter was not even brought up for discussion at an Apex Board meeting. Since the Apex Board has never voted on this issue, the letter was sent in error and should be recalled. Once the letter is recalled, the Apex Board should vote on the site selection.

Mayor Weatherly and the Apex Board of Commissioners must realize that when mistakes are made, it is best to admit the errors and then take corrective action. It is never appropriate to try to cover up your errors.

Mayor Weatherly and many of the Commissioners have publicly defended the site selection process. They have said that they have faith in the process. The residents of New Hill have lost faith. Will the Mayor and the Commissioners be willing to rectify this error in the process? Or will they simply shrug their shoulders and allow the process to continue? Apex can and should fix this mistake.
