I am writing in reference to the Western Wake Regional Waste Water Treatment Facility. The Final EIS is incomplete, inaccurate, and misleading. For example:

Executive Summary: Lines 399 - 401

“Meetings with the public also occurred during the project. There was a meeting with EPA in May 2008 in New Hill and two open houses are also planned to be held during the public comment period for the EIS.”

We are currently in the public comment period for the Final EIS, and I am not aware of any open houses that are planned.

Having this false statement in the Executive Summary leaves the reader to conclude there will be an opportunity for the public to verbally express their concerns during the Final EIS review.

This appears to be yet another attempt to deceive the public reading only the Executive Summary and sway the public's opinion of the Final EIS.
