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Mr. Wicker,

In reviewing the responses in the FEIS document, I still have concerns.

Questions about odor, noise, lights, contamination of wells (our only source of drinking water), streams and ponds are not adequately answered. These conditions were covered in the response by saying there will be minimum spills, noise, and pollution and never has a well been contaminated by a sewage spill. They also tell us about buffers around the site. I have never heard of a buffer eliminating these conditions.

We are a small community, but have four churches where many of our social events are held. Any amount of odor would be unacceptable at our annual homecomings (which includes picnics on the grounds) at New Hill Baptist Church, New Hill First Missionary Baptist Church, Cedar Rock Baptist Church, and Shady Grove Baptist Church. We also have annual Vacation Bible Schools, barbecues, festivals, special event dinners and a year-round playground for all the children in the area.

There are no specific plans for supplying drinking water in case of contaminated wells. The response to that was they have never had contamination of wells and in case this happens it will be handled in the same way as in town or just outside of town.

If the site is moved to Progress Energy site, the community of New Hill would not be affected in any way. Minimal or few conditions are not acceptable because after accidents happen, it is too late to stop the adverse effect.

We have covered all of these topics before, but NOBODY IS LISTENING.

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
