It is reasonable to expect that this process be transparent instead of appearing to be secretive. We are therefore asking to be informed of the date, time and location of any such meetings. If there is a valid reason that a member of the New Hill Community Association cannot be a part of or at least attend any such meetings, we would welcome an explanation.
