

No vote or public forum? Something stinks in Apex

Regarding the Western Wake Sewage Plant, it seems that the deeper we look, the more secretive the deals appear relating to the site selection of the plant.

The Town of Apex has granted Cary their approval to condemn the Seymour Farm, not through

a public hearing and vote of the Council, but through a letter quietly written from Mayor Weatherly (Apex) to Mayor McAllister (Cary).

The Apex Town Council, its citizens, and other affected communities had no opportunity to discuss the site selection in a

public forum until after the deal was done.

This level of underhandedness and avoidance of public representation is shocking, and should not be accepted.
