This is to inform the Western Wake Partners that the SEPA (State) environmental review process has been suspended in lieu of the NEPA (Federal) EIS process determined to be necessary by the US Army Corps of Engineers to support an individual Section 404 Permit for the proposed project. However, the Division of Water Quality will continue to work with the ACOE to support the NEPA EIS process. It is also anticipated that much of the work already completed by the Partners during the SEPA review process will be merged into the NEPA EIS process.

Additionally, at such time as the ACOE advertises the Draft EIS for public comment, the Division of Water Quality will accept a revised Preliminary Engineering Report that reflects any design changes in the proposed project as a result of the NEPA EIS process and the NPDES permit application.
